Extended access clinics

We are now part of a shared service based at Prospect House in Kettering which offers appointments at evenings and weekends. This service is shared between GP surgeries in the Kettering area.

The extended access clinic offers appointments with:

- GP's
- Nurse Practitioners
- Pediatric Nurses
- Practice Nurses
- Mental Health practitioners
- Physio's

They also offer video consultations where appropriate.
